The foundation's key project is the development of solar energy cooperatives in rural communities, providing training and resources for sustainable energy production and local economic development.

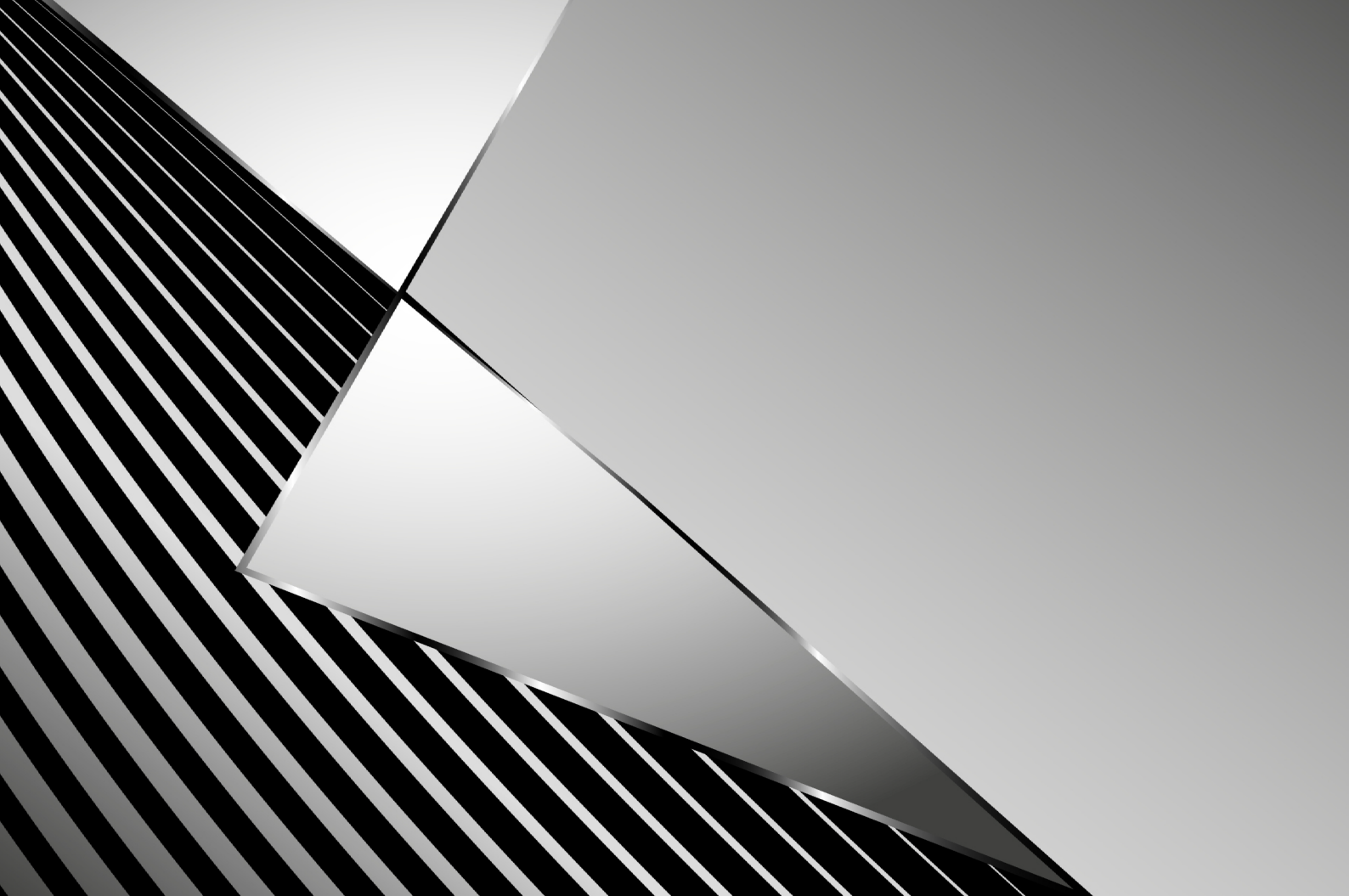


Development & Implementation of the Baltic Pipe Project
